

HOLY TRINITY RE-OPENING – Phase 2 Return Instructions

Please monitor the Alberta COVID-19 [Guidance for Places of Worship](#) for updated procedures:

Agape Meal	No Agape meal / lunch will NOT happen until the Province gives the go-ahead. You can eat at home or a restaurant – as you wish.
Are you Sick?	Please stay home and pray. Typikas will be distributed to all emails on the parish list until completely back to normal. Call Fr. Daniel if you need anointing or home communion. Take on line self-assessment .
Assisting Church	Support the parish with your prayers, attendance, and financial support. Donations can be through CanadaHelps.org or by cheque – preferably not by cash or coin, please.
Attendance	We have room for around 20 members and visiting guests under current guidelines. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - At door please give greeter your name in case anyone in the parish reports coming down with the virus. You can quickly be contacted and go for testing. - Sanitize hands on entry and exit. - Places marked with an X will be available for seating. Please ask the Greeter for assistance. - Follow physical distancing guidelines of 6 ft /2 mtrs. apart.
Communion & Antidoron	Approach altar watching distance markers on floor for physical distance. Open mouth and lean back so Eucharist can be dropped into your mouth. Do not kiss chalice or priest's hand.
Kissing	We love to kiss and hug in the Church, but for the time being, please refrain from kissing or hugging people. Blow a kiss, bow, wave. Venerating icons – for now, please bow and pray before them. If you forget yourself and kiss, please let the Greeter know and it will be sanitized.
Masks and Gloves	Masks are now a requirement unless you are unable to wear one for medical reasons. Gloves are not a requirement but if used, please bring fresh gloves or sanitize the gloves you will be using when you enter the Church.
Signs	There will be instructional signs posted throughout the church. Please read them and be aware of content.
Washrooms	If you use the washroom, please sanitize sink and door knob before leaving.
